


Important Masajid










3. Masjid al-Aqsa - The third most sacred Masjid in the world. It is the very place where all the prophets we prayed together during al Isra wal Miraj.










MASJID AL-AQSA INCLUDES:

Sulaiman's Monument




There are many Madrassa in Masjid Al-Aqsa. This was a monument for Prophet Sulaiman www who passed away near here. It has been changed into a girl's school.

Fountains and Wells


Also know as Qubbat As-Sukhrah

There are many fountains and wells in Masjid Al–Aqsa. This fountain is near Masjid Qibly where people can do wudhu.




6 Dome of Ascension

This dome reminds us when our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ went into Heaven from this area.


6 Archways




The whole land of the Masjid Al-Aqsa sanctuary and its buildings are precious and blessed.





In the Holy Qur'an, Allah mentions both Al-Aqsa and Jerusalem as blessed.

Did you know that many Sahabah and Prophets in are buried in or near Masjid Al-Aqsa.





THE NIGHT JOURNEY


Our story begins with our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was one night sleeping in the house of Umm Hani. This house was very near the Holy Kab'ah.





The Buraq looked like a horse with wings. It took our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ on an amazing journey to Masjid Al-Aqsa.




The Buraq travelled at a very high speed. Each stride of the Buraq was as far as the eye could see.
